

CLARIFICATION IN PUBLIC INTEREST:

Parle Agro's Recruitment Process

It has been brought to our attention that certain racketeers are sending out false emails, letters, and website links purporting to be from Parle Agro Pvt Ltd. The emails ask the recipient to appear for a face-to-face interview for a job opening with Parle Agro, or a job offer from Parle Agro and to deposit a certain amount as a refundable interview security in a designated bank account. The emails, letters, website links sent out have false names, fake authorized signatory, fake URL that are not secure, are not our employees and are falsely stated to be from officials of Parle Agro's HR Department. Parle Agro has not sent out any such URL, emails or letters for recruitment. Please note that Parle Agro, as a policy, does not collect any money as a pre-employment requirement, neither do we permit our external recruitment partners to collect/charge any fees from candidates. Parle Agro and its affiliate companies bear no responsibility for amounts being deposited / withdrawn therefrom in response to such emails.

Parle Agro is taking appropriate steps to tackle the issue.

We require you to be a vigilant jobseeker, please look out for the following pointers to identify the fraudulent emails as these communications may carry the ID, URL or domain name of Parle Agro (or a deceptively similar name) to make it look authentic:

- Any email received from any domain other than the actual '@parleagro.com'; for example, '@parleagro.work' etc., is a spurious email. We do not send interview call letters to candidates on the company letterhead, or any URL address/link that differs from the company name, nor do we have any sort of watermark image on our Letterhead. Please note these letters are all erroneous and spurious letters. Moreover, please ensure that you check our company website or our LinkedIn page, to ensure that the organization logo used in the communication, is authentic."
- A fraudulent email may mention the bank account number of an individual or the account details would be given upon calling up on the number mentioned in the fraudulent mail. In any case the bank account would not be in the name of "Parle Agro Pvt Ltd."

We advise candidates not to respond to any fraudulent emails and not to make any payments.

We would like to reiterate Parle Agro does not ask for any money from the candidate at any stage of the recruitment process. Neither do we permit our external recruitment partners to collect/charge any fees from candidates.
